Daily Environmental Conditions:-

- Weather.

In the event of a person requiring emergency transport a support vehicle is available.

NOTE – while there is a daily journey / mileage target – travel on the day will be dictated by local conditions and appropriate actions will be taken in the best interest of health and safety considerations.

The **TED40** journey is a demanding physical challenge; it will require a dedicated and focused team effort. Daily legs can and will be influenced by, local traffic conditions, road-works, weather conditions and the stamina of the team members. It is paramount that while taking on the challenge, that all team members return safely and enjoy the event on the day.
